Advanced Pathway

The Advanced Pathway is bespoke to students who wish to study A Level and Level 3 Applied General qualifications.

These courses enable students to choose subjects that are tailored towards their future careers and supports students by investing in developing transferable skills.

All our Advanced Pathway students' study a minimum of three subjects over two years. Our Level 3 Applied General qualifications are a combination of exams and coursework, with students able to select a combination of A Level courses.

Our Sixth Formers receive a number of unique privileges, including a dedicated area for working and socialising, the chance to act as a role model for younger students, through mentoring schemes and outstanding careers advice, including guidance on UCAS and job applications.

The Advanced Pathway supports students to go on to university, higher education or graduate apprenticeships.



A Level Qualifications

To be considered for A Level qualifications, you must have a minimum of a Grade 4 in English and Maths.

Business Studies	3	 Grade 4 or above in English and Maths. Ideally a Level 2 Pass or above in Business Studies.
Computing	3	 Grade 4 or above in English and Maths. Ideally a Level 2 qualification in a computer-based subject.
Criminology	3	Grade 4 or above in English and Maths.
Esports	3	 Grade 4 or above in English and Maths. Ideally a Level 2 qualification in a computer-based subject.
Food, Science & Nutrition	3	 Grade 4 or above in English and Maths. Level 2 qualification in Catering.
Information Technology	3	 Grade 4 or above in English and Maths. Ideally a Level 2 qualification in a computer-based subject.



Foundation Pathway

Our Level 1 and 2 Courses are designed for students who have not yet achieved a Grade 4 in English and/or Maths. Students on this pathway will study three subjects, which will include English and/or Maths as required, along with at least one optional subject.

These one-year courses provide essential support in working towards achieving a GCSE Grade 4 or, the equivalent Functional Skills qualifications in both subjects.




Our Students
