Course Aims:

Sport are designed around practical skills and tasks that place an emphasis on learners demonstrating what they can do rather than what they know in theory. The qualifications give learners the opportunity to acquire and develop generic, transferable and sector-specific skills in order to complete tasks and a level of achievement that enables them to progress to further learning.

The Award offers a taster of the sports sector and could be studied alongside other subjects.

Course Content and Assessment:

The objectives of this qualification are to:

- develop learners' skills and techniques and use of visual language and formal elements in art and design
- extend learners' knowledge and understanding of the design process
- extend learners' understanding of health and safety issues relating to art and design
- provide the opportunity for personal development
- provide a basis for progression onto further study.

- development of transferable skills means that learners can also choose a study programme from
- alternative sectors. For example, these qualifications in sport could lead to Pearson BTEC Level 2

- or to Level 2 qualifications in other sectors.
