Overview:

If you are interested in pursuing a career which involves working with other people, whether this is within a Hospital and Healthcare setting, then this is the course for you!

It covers a wide range of areas including dementia awareness, mental health and well-being, supporting individuals with their physical and emotional care, daily living needs and healthcare procedures. The content is also aligned with the knowledge and skills required for the Adult Care Worker and Healthcare Support Worker Apprenticeship standards.

Course Content and Assessment:

You must achieve a total of 46 credits with 24 credits from mandatory units and a minimum of 22 credits from the optional units.

All units are internally assessed by the teacher using a portfolio of evidence.

Knowledge-based outcomes are assessed through assessment tasks provided.

Work experience is compulsory within this qualification to demonstrate competence in both knowledge and skills.

Course Overview:

Mandatory units are:

1. Communicatio in care settings
2. Handle information in care settings
3. Personal development in care settings
4. Implement personal-centred approaches in care settings
5. Equality & inclusion in care settings
6. Health, safety and well-being in care settings
7. Responsibilities of a care worker
8. Durty of care
9. Safeguarding in care settings

Example optional units included but not limited to:

1. Causes and spread of infection
2. Understand mental health problems
3. Provide support for mobility
4. Principles of health promotion
5. Undertake physiological measurements

Learning Methods:

You will develop skills and knowledge to prepare you to work with children through a variety of different tasks

We will encourage you to take responsibility for your own learning. This will help prepare you for further study or for progression to direct employment in the Early Years sector.

Career Opportunities:

Upon completion, learners can enter either the adult care or health workforces. The content is applicable to a variety of roles, including:

- adult care worker
- healthcare assistant/support worker
- personal assistant.

This qualification would also allow you to progress onto an apprenticeship.
